The physicians and staff of Southeast Radiation Oncology Center believe that healing is a communal experience, best achieved close to home, surrounded by the support of family and friends. For this reason, they paused to reflect mid-construction and asked the community to share messages of hope and healing for all those who would one day receive treatment.

More than 150 individuals from Juneau attended the event on that glorious sunny day in August, 2013 to share words of encouragement. Many more – moved by the importance of this event – emailed their thoughts, mailed in their messages and called with their words. These inscriptions are offered with heartfelt inspiration to all touched by cancer – patients, physicians, caregivers, and family members. Sometimes the words mirror the surface on which they are written – raw, filled with struggle and fight; more often they reflect hope and encouragement. But in every way they are all **Written in Stone**, inscribed on the unfinished concrete walls of the treatment room and permanently embedded in the physical make-up of the facility of healing.

This commemorative book is published in recognition of those who came to share on that day and who have felt the impact of cancer. It is to remind those receiving daily treatment that many have stood around the perimeter where they lie in support of their journey. It is in recognition that healing happens not only through access to state of the art clinical care, but also in concert with the support of family and a community of caregivers.

The physicians and clinical care team believe in practicing H.O.P.E


